PROGRAM UPDATES:

Sarah Bowman updated those in attendance on the Eddy County Health Council. She stated that the topics of highest concern to the Council are Women's Health Care and Cardiovascular Disease and that our area has troubling numbers regarding each of these. Surveys will be going out to poll the community on what issues are of most concern. Joana Wells invited everyone to the Community Safety Briefing that will be held on April 20th at the Pecos River Village. A panel discussion is planned to cover topics such as

mental health, crime, neighborhood watches, Teens in Action, and Community in Action efforts. She also invited everyone to the next Community Impact Council meeting on Friday, April 14th with SIMCO hosting at the Skeen Whitlock Building. As a fundraiser for Class Act, the Coalition staff and Teens In Action are working on "Prom Potties" which will run for two weeks. Toilets will be painted to be placed in homes and businesses across the community and residents/business owners will pay to have them placed in another location. The idea is to promote a safe and sober prom night while also raising funds for Class Act in which graduating seniors can spend their graduation night in a fun and safe location. Samantha Smith reported the recent golden eggs outreach went well with the Sources of Strength students at Carlsbad High School. Coalition staff reported the All Stars program will be wrapping up within the month in both Carlsbad and Loving schools. Hannah Ornelas handed out flyers containing the annual Community Survey information. She asked everyone to please promote and distribute as much as possible. CPD Officer Mike Shott explained that they're looking to hire another SRO in time for next school year. Joana Wells reported that ConocoPhillips donated \$10,000 for another K-9. Trystan Messer of Southeast NM Child Advocacy Center reported that they are now able to provide play therapy and have 4 clinicians that can do so.
