PROGRAM UPDATES:

Julie discussed Teen Court which has moved to the municipal annex on Monday's. Teen court is getting more referrals. Teen court is still looking for more youth lawyers and can apply at www.carlsbadcoaliton.com/teencourt. STOP is working with AV 6th grade classes via google classroom with the All-star program. TOP has moved to Thursday in the AM. We are down to 14 youth from 20. They just finished working on posters for Candy Gram school fundraiser and doing Valentines cards for meals on wheels for community service-learning hours. Teens in action are working on making campaign slogans for social media, schools and community using footage from the concert. SPF is working on the All Stars Plus program via google classroom for the 8th grades at PR Leyva. They will complete 14 lessons over the semester. OSAP has completed mid-year grant. Samantha has delivered bag tags to several pharmacies and working on sending out reusable grocery bags with information on safe drug disposal.

OLD BUSINESS: N/A

NEW BUSINESS/ANNOUNCEMENTS: The DWI program has a new Prevention/Educator, Brandi Mendoza. Brandi invited everyone to meetings on Tuesdays via zoom. Rights now they working on doing several roadblocks with the CPD and Sheriff department over the next week weeks. Eddie Sanchez is working with YDI which is a program that focuses on intervention, rehabilitation, reunification and work on prevention. They work off referrals. They have a 99% success rate from graduation in the programs. They help with customizing a program that fits the family's needs with drug abuse, family needs and work with CYFD. The program does not have a cost. Works with an adult and teen life skills program and will be running monthly from the battered women's shelter. Tammy Frintz would like to extend an invite for our meetings to the school Resource officers. They could give the Coalition more information as to what they are seeing at the schools right now and how the Coalition could help them. Kids these ages are not exactly what all the drugs that are out there and how they could affect them.
