ABOUT TEEN COURT

- Teen Court is a program for individuals age 12-18 who are charged with traffic violations, shoplifting less than \$250 value, possession of alcohol or drugs, disorderly conduct and other misdemeanor offenses.
- Referring agencies: Municipal Court, Magistrate Court, Juvenile Probation and Parole Office and Carlsbad Municipal Schools.

TEEN DEFENDANTS MUST:

- Admit to charges
- Appear at the sentencing hearing with parent, guardian, or custodian.
- Complete sentence within the allotted time frame
- Follow the Teen Court Rules of Conduct.
- Not commit any other offenses while serving their sentence in Teen Court

TEEN ATTORNEYS WILL:

- Be mentored by local judges and experienced attorneys on how to prosecute and defend cases.
- Improve your public speaking skills and open many doors of opportunity.

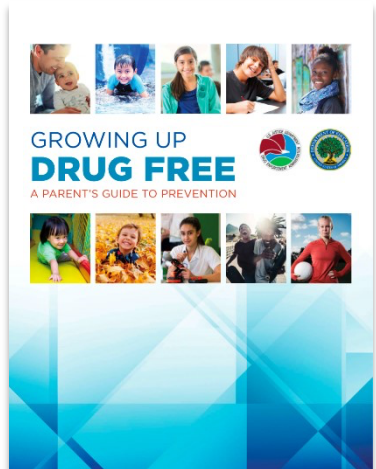
