Carlsbad Police Dept./Student Resource Officer Andrew Matta reported on the high number of instances at Carlsbad High School in which Narcan has been needed for use on students who have overdosed.

According to Matta, CPD is needing to use it just about daily in the community for their incoming calls for help. Ekta Bhatka introduced herself as the new Community Relations representative for SIMCO and will be replacing Donovan Mager who has just retired from the company. She is working on developing a new grant opportunity for SIMCO (Salado Isolation Mining Contractors) to implement in the future for the community. The Coalition staff emphasized the importance of parental/guardian involvement for the youth in our community as they are seeing very little participation with students. Julie Fuentes reported the Loving students saw success in implementing their personal hygiene product carts making them available for everyone's use. Students are using the products and she is proud of them for taking the initiative on that project.
