Factoid of the Month:

According to the Carlsbad Coalition's Evidence Based Program All-Star's Pretest Report at the Carlsbad and Loving Middle School 8th graders reported:

1. Most students are NOT using substances
2. Most students think their peers ARE using substances or do not know if they are
3. All sites had the highest % of students rating "thinking about their future" as the most important protective factor, but the rest of the protective factors vary across school sites.
4. All sites rate their peers as the lowest when it comes to disapproval of alcohol use (the students themselves are pretty similar to their parents (meaning they think it is just about as wrong as they think their parents believe it is for them to use alcohol).

PROGRAM UPDATES:

Organization Highlight: Isaac Florez – High School SRO

- THC Cartridges on 4 Students – 1st day of school (more 2nd day and on)
- Numerous fights through end of August.
- Referrals to Teen Court in lieu of suspensions
- Numerous threats through anonymous app: YikYak
YikYak cooperated with law enforcement and provided phone number and coordinates for phone used to post threats.
- School Lock Downs so far this year: High School x1, Cottonwood Elementary x2, Alta Vista x2
- Student overdose at High School last week – SRO and nurse both had to administer Narcan to a male in the library (2 does of 4mg) before he came to. Initially thought it was a Perc-30, realized it was fake and chose to take it anyway. Purchased out of town. Blue color pressed in Perc-30 pill press – blue residue in container with residue on dollar bill – indicating he snorted the crushed powder - investigation continuing on source of pills
- Active Shooter Training: ALICE (Alert, lockdown, inform, counter, evacuate) training completed for Carlsbad and Loving School staff – available for any groups that would like to be trained.

Teen Court: 4 referrals from Loving Schools for Marijuana infractions

SPF-PFS: Started All-Stars programming with 23 8th graders in Health Class at Loving Middle School. Also began programming with 8th Grade Health students at CIS: PR Leyva.

TOP: Started programming in Loving with 10 students at LHS. Adding second class with possibility of 10 additional students beginning this month. Held parent training August 31 and had 5 adult present.

STOP: Still trying to get programming scheduled with Mrs. Salcido at Alta Vista for this semester in Social Studies for 6th graders. May have to delay and do both sets 2nd semester. Hoping to add PR Leyva 6th graders with next grant cycle award.

OSAH: Planning programming with Carlsbad High School administration for schoolwide curriculum implementation and campaigns for 2nd semester this school year. Hoping

OSAP: Began programming implementation with 8th Grade Health classes at CIS: Alta Vista. Working with local cannabis companies to distribute information on locking up marijuana and providing fingerprint cabinet locks to prevent unwanted access. Eddie Sanchez mentioned seeing “Lock Up Marijauna” flyers that we’ve distributed in the community and advertised by a local distribution company.

Red Ribbon Week: “Celebrating Life: Live Drug Free” – The story of DEA Agent Enrique Camarena. Amazon Prime: “The Last Narc” – the story of Agent Camarena’s life. Discussed making this year’s Red Ribbon Week community wide instead of only within the schools. Looking to meet with anyone interested in helping this month. Please reach out if you’d
